



Abel "LOBO" Montoya

September 22, 1950 - November 22, 2024

Abel "Lobo" Montoya, 74, of Pueblo, CO, went to be with the Lord on November 22, 2024. He was preceded in death by his parents, Frank and Sophie Montoya, his best friends, Charlie Gonzales and Maggie Baldonado, and numerous biker brothers. He is survived by his siblings, Virginia Gamboa, Jerry (Gloria) Montoya, and Larry (Marie) Montoya, his children, MaryJo (Ernest Herrera) Montoya, Nadine (Steve) Donoho, Lynette (Jeff) Bales, and April (Ricky Riggs) Maes; his grandchildren, Nathan (Jasmine) Herrera, Jacob (Trinity) Herrera, Sophia, Joshua, and Lucas Donoho, Remi Riggs, Ashley (Tasche) Kravig, and Cody Bales; and his great-grandchildren, Mariana, Alicia, and Mateo Hererra, Paisley, and Wyatt Kravig. Lobo is also survived by biker brothers and sisters, nieces, nephews, extended family, and friends. As a young man, he and his brothers were all drafted into the Army at the same time, where he spent most of his time serving in Germany. After the military, he found a love of lowriding and became one of the first in Pueblo to have hydraulics on his '64 Chevy Impala SS and a member of the Luv-n-Low Car Club. His lifelong love for motorcycle riding began with a Honda Chopper and later had multiple custom-painted Harleys. He loved the freedom that came with riding with his brotherhood. He was a dedicated founding member of the Pueblo Toy Run. The Chieftain published countless articles recognizing Lobo and his biker brothers for serving the community. Lobo loved spending time with his family and friends and never missed an event. Still riding his bike up until two months before passing, he lived his life on his terms,

unapologetically, and always reminded us, “Hey, it’s your world, I’m just passing through.”
