Agnes (Aggie) Rebecca Martinez (Montoya) 77, Pueblo, Colorado passed away on Friday, October 20, 2023. Aggie was born on February 8, 1946 in Walsenburg, Colorado. 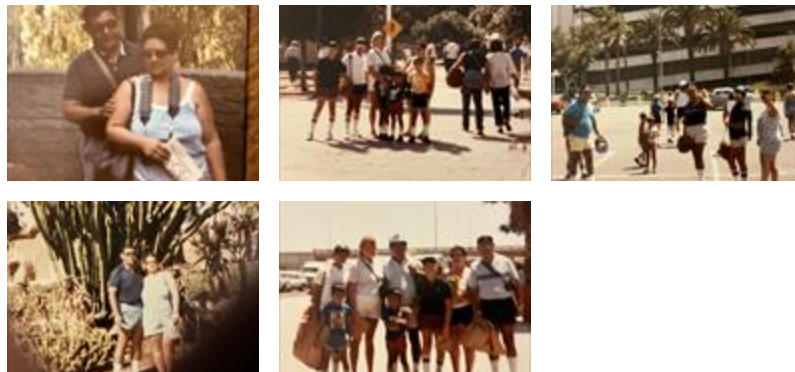
