While in Longmont he was very involved

with Saint John's the Baptist Catholic Church where he served on the Parish Council, taught catechism, helped build the Samaritan House along with many other activities. His career took him to Pueblo, Colorado where he lived the next 40 years of his life. After a very successful career he retired as the District Director of Southeast Colorado. Upon his retirement he fostered his love for cars and nature. Alex did not build cars or show cars he just bought new ones constantly. On any given day of the week, you could find him on the car lot. If he wasn't at the car lot, he would be watching his grandchildren play sports, traveling to various places to spend time with his grandchildren or driving to his condo in Chuchara, Colorado.
