



## Barbara Falcon Nelson-Cooper

Barbara Falcon Nelson-Cooper was born in Brockton Massachusetts on July 18, 1949 and transitioned on January 15, 2022 in Pueblo, Colorado at age 72. Barbara spent her formative years in Massachusetts, the youngest of three siblings; brother Paul (deceased) and sister Cathy Baker of Florida.
