Daniel Puente, 87, of Pueblo, born April 30, 1935, passed away on December 15, 2021. He was preceded in death by his parents and siblings. He is survived by his wife of 57 years Anne Puente; sons, Daniel Andrew Puente and Stephen Eric Puente; numerous nieces, nephews and cousins. Daniel graduated from Pueblo Central High School in 1954.
