



## Edward George Aragon

January 17, 1950 - August 3, 2022

Edward (Eduardo) George Aragón, 72, of Pueblo left this earthly life to begin his eternal life on August 3, 2022. He bravely fought Lewy Body Dementia for several years and was cared for by his wife and youngest daughter Sierra at home until the last 6 weeks.

Edward was preceded in death by his parents, Miguel and Adela, first wife Emily, two sisters, Flora Lucero and Fabiola Armenta, and three brothers, Freddie, Philip, and Arthur Aragón

He is survived by his wife Jan and all five of his children.

Edward began life in La Junta, Colorado in January of 1950. He was the youngest of eleven children of Miguel and Adela Aragón of Rocky Ford, Colorado.

On October 2, 1968, he married his first wife, Emily Robbins (20 years). They made their home in Huntington Beach, California and later in Longmont, Colorado and in Pueblo, Colorado. Together they had four children, Brad Hardman (Jerri), Holly Guagliardo (Kevin), Robin Ermer (Al), and Scott Aragón (Molly). He was widowed in 1987. He had 9 grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

In 1989, Edward met Jan Saiz at his niece's wedding in Farmington, NM on

September 9th. He proposed on December 9th, and they were married on June 9th. Together they had one daughter, Sierra (Robert). They made their home in Farmington, NM for seven years and later moved to Pueblo, Colorado where they lived for the past twenty-five years.

In his younger years, Edward worked for US Divers testing diving equipment where he interacted with Jacques Cousteau. He also worked for Lear Siegler where they manufactured air conditioning units for airplanes and subway cars. He was a department lead, a union rep and a worker's advocate while working there.

Edward was a talented artist making pottery in high school and later working with oils and pastels creating landscapes and still life paintings. He drew incredible pencil drawings of Jesus, most of which he gave to family and friends. He always was so incredibly proud to see his creations hanging.

Edward was a kind, loving partner and the best father. He loved his extended family and would not hesitate to visit. He was generous and never met a stranger. Edward was the best listener and confidant to many.
