July 29, 1937 - October 31, 2018

Felix Serafin Cordova, 81, of Pueblo, went to be with the Lord on October 31, 2018, after a long fought battle with kidney disease. He was preceded in death by his son, Mitchell Cordova; parents, Augustine and Eremita Cordova and brother, Arturo Cordova. Felix is survived by his spouse of 59 years, Tina Cordova; sons, Ken Cordova and Steve (Patty) Cordova; grandchildren, Steve, Kenneth (Savannah), Natalie (Manny) and Felix (Kara); great grandchildren, Gwynn, Thunder, Charli, Olivia, Gabriella and Felix Adam; siblings, Santiago (Patricia) and Augustine; in-law, Pricilla; along with numerous nieces, nephews, extended family and friends. Felix was born in Taos, New Mexico on July 29, 1937. Felix was a proud Marine who served in the United States Marine Corps, from 1954-1957, before moving to Pueblo, Colorado. Felix first got involved with the community by helping bring improvements to the Hyde Park neighborhood, while also raising three sons with his lovely wife, Tina. He was a hardworking family man, who made a mark in the community as a political activist for the Democratic Party and became a household name during his tenure with the presidential campaign for Gary Hart. He was the co-founder of the Jac-X-Press and the Pueblo Chicano Democratic Caucus, in an effort to create a voice for the local Hispanic community. While working at the CF&I, he was able to earn a Bachelor of Arts in Behavioral Sciences at Southern Colorado State College. He later attended the Police Academy and landed a job as an investigator with the District Attorney's Office, which led to him translating for the local courts.

He was a caring soul that wore many hats. He was many things to a lot of people. He was a supportive husband, a loving father, an amazing grandfather, a staple in the local community and was loved by everyone that he came across.
