Jeffrey Michael Gallegos, left this earth peacefully surrounded by loved ones on Saturday, March 7 2015. Jeffrey graduated from Centennial High School in 1984 and studied at UNC in Greeley; but it was through dance that he learned all he needed to know in life. He started dancing with Sarah Shaw at the age of four and went on to become an award-winning choreographer and director. His talents took him on many adventures from Alaska to Argentina, Japan to the Caribbean where his creativity, kind nature and charismatic personality made him a favorite amongst his theatre family. He starred in, directed or choreographed 100s of shows around the US and abroad, including Evita, Camelot, Dreamgirls, and Phantom. He won the Denver Critics Award for “Choreographer of the Year” for his work on “Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat”. Jeffrey is survived by his mother, Carolyn Gallegos; his sister Lee (Rusty) Pagano; his niece and god-daughter, Megan; nephew, Noah; and by numerous aunts, uncles, cousins.
