Justin David Williams, age 38, of Pueblo, Colorado, passed away on January 3, 2026. Justin proudly served in the United States Army as a 68F Physical Therapy Specialist. He completed Basic Combat Training at Fort Sill in Lawton, Oklahoma, where he was named Distinguished Honor Graduate, and continued his training at Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio, Texas. His service took him overseas to Vilseck, Germany, where he was stationed at Rose Barracks and worked at the Vilseck Army Health Clinic. He later served at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, where he helped establish the Army's Holistic Health and Fitness (H2F) facility, before returning home to Colorado for his final duty station at Fort Carson in Colorado Springs. Justin loved the Army and the brotherhood it gave him. Serving alongside his fellow soldiers and forming lifelong friendships was something he was deeply proud of.
