She took care of many of us thru our bad health and many others thru their deaths and then she'd work her grief out helping family sort thru their things to clean up the mess. I very much value the time she and I shared even with the conflicts we had at times.

I very much regret Tammy didn't go thru having a service. I made the rounds telling everyone I knew of that knew her there would be a service and obit in the paper soon. Out of my control though. The local homeless outfit Posada had a remembrance a month ago and Rhonda was talked about by some that knew her. I regret that I couldn't find where it was being held, I went where I thought it was to be and nothing there. Looked around and couldn't find the place. I feel very bad about missing that as I had some good words I wanted to share about her.
