



Richard Joseph Avina

July 12, 1952 - July 11, 2025

Richard “Rip” Joseph Aviña passed away peacefully on July 11, 2025, just one day shy of his 73rd birthday. He was a beloved father, son, brother, uncle, partner, educator, and DJ whose life was marked by a deep love for family, music, and community. He was preceded in death by his father Joseph Isador Atencio, grandmother Concepcion Aviña, sister Lorraine Atencio Fields, and stepfather M.G. Salas. He is survived by his sons Russell (Nicole) Aviña and Adam Aviña; his mother Jennie Salas; siblings Robert (Ellen) Salas, Ronald Salas, Reuben (Phyllis) Salas, Ronald Atencio, Leonard (Kathy) Atencio, Annette (Jim) Atencio Bubak, and Trina (James) Atencio Cleveland; significant other Mary Ellen Trujillo; former wife Lorraine Aviña; and numerous nieces and nephews. Richard dedicated over 20 years to education, guiding and inspiring generations of students. He taught at Columbian Elementary School and retired from Pueblo Academy of Arts, mentor and father figure to many. Before that, he was a DJ known as “Rip” who filled rooms and hearts with music from the ’70s through the 2000s. He never lost his passion for spinning vinyl, and his jam sessions were legendary among friends and family. A proud Colorado Rockies fan, Richard loved spending summer days at the ballpark and made it a goal to visit stadiums around the country. He was also a lifelong Broncos fan, proud CU Buff and Navy parent, always cheering loudly from the stands. Richard’s presence lit up every room. He never met a stranger and was known for his warmth, humor, and generosity. His memory will live on in the music he loved, the stories he told, and the lives he touched.

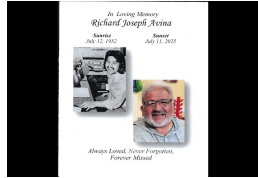

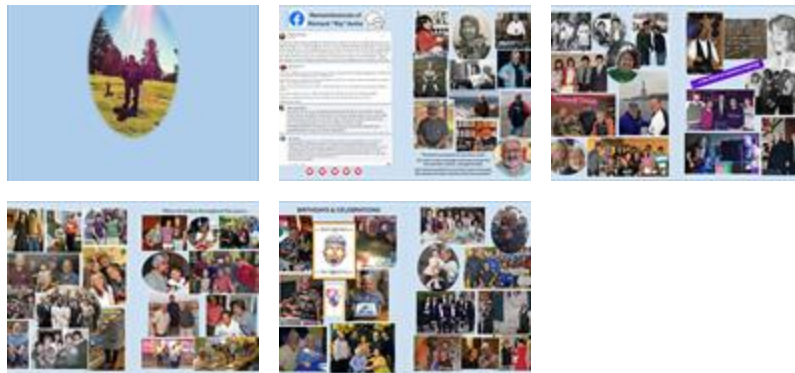
