Ricky J. Muñiz, passed away September 14, 2015. Born January 9, 1983 in Pueblo to Pam and Rick Camargo, Ricky (aka "Zinum") was a musician and guitarist with a big heart for friends, family and strangers alike. Ricky was one of the most talented rock and heavy metal guitarists of his generation, playing gigs with his bands Spinedown (formed with his brother Ronnie) and Into Awakening at the Chief and Phil's Radiator Shop in Pueblo, Industrial Nation and Sunshine Studios in Colorado Springs, the F.O.E. Hall in Canon City, and several other Venues around Colorado. He was employed with All Seasons Catering, and had received Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior, getting baptized in the waters of the Arkansas River with New Beginnings Church on August 23, 2015. Ricky used his incredible musical talent to play guitar and drums for church services, including the Spanish ministry. On his last day he was doing what he always did—playing guitar, spending time with family, and protecting his home. Ricky was preceded in death by his grandparents Henry and Frances Muñiz, his puppy Beavis, and cat Peanut.
